Graphic Design Diploma Applicants: Research Kenyan artist, Wangechi, and her new album titled “#Don’t Consume if Seal is Broken.” Draw or design a new album cover. The album cover should reflect the vibe of her music.

Animation Diploma Applicants: Netflix is looking for a Kenyan animation to feature on its global website. The show is a sci-fi adventure about a superhero or superheroine living in the year 2116; the superhero or superheroine needs to defeat cyber thieves, giant evil frogs, and aliens pretending to be police officers. The target audience is teens between the ages of 13 to 16. Submit the name of the animation show along with a drawing of the superhero or superheroine you imagine for this animation.

Mass Communication Applicants: Interview someone you admire from your community and write a powerful story about that person in a 1-page blog, which will reach 10,000 Kenyans.

Sound Engineering Applicants: Listen to the following song “Obama Tribute,” which you can find here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6vI_RkHbHjA. Tell us what instruments you hear during the intro and then throughout the song. Do you hear one vocalist or more? What do you like or don’t like about the song.

Music Production Applicants: Record a 1-minute video of you singing, rapping, creating beats, or playing an instrument of your choice. Submit the video on a DVD.

Multimedia Certificate Applicants: Pick a place you love. Write a 1-page blog about this place and add elements of multimedia, which could include a photograph or video you take using a camera or phone.

Photography Certificate Applicants: Submit a photograph you have taken with your phone or camera. Write a caption for the photograph as well as a 1-paragraph description of the photograph and why it is important to you.

Digital Marketing Certificate Applicants: The Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC) has hired you to launch a campaign that will discourage violence in the upcoming 2017 elections. Describe in 1-page how you would design and carry out this digital campaign.

SECTION 9: ADMI POLICIES AND DECLARATION

English-Language Proficiency: The language of instruction at ADMI is English. As a result, candidates whose first language is not English or who did not go to an education system with English as the language of instruction will be required to demonstrate adequate English language proficiency.

Admission: ADMI reserves the right to grant or refuse admission to any individual. Former applicants or students who have lost good standing may be denied re-entry, or may have conditions placed on readmission.

Number of Accepted Students per Intake: All programmes are capped at 24 students, except for Sound Engineering and Music Production, which are capped at 9 and 18 students respectively.

Payment: Once a student has been accepted into a programme, his/her place is only confirmed after a minimum payment (50% of the first term's fees and required medical insurance) has been made. This initial payment must be made by 5, 2017. Payments made after this date will not be accepted, and students will not be able to enroll for the 2017 intake.

Programme Cancellation: ADMI reserves the right to cancel a programme for operational reasons. When ADMI cancels a programme, all fees (including the application fee) will be refunded. ADMI will notify students and parents of any cancellations by April 25, 2017.

Time Commitment: All students should be aware that classes can be scheduled on Monday to Fridays from 8:30am to 8:30pm as well as Saturdays from 8:30am to 4:00pm. The class timetable will be given at the start of each term, and it is the student's responsibility to attend all classes. Class timings will not be moved to accommodate students' other commitments.
